### VODKA

#### TYRRELLS

Tyrrell's vodka is made in Hereford using the potatoes that are too big to be used for crisps and are traditional varieties produced in small quantities. The vodka is distilled in small batches using original artisan methods in a traditional copper still to make a smooth, creamy tasting vodka.

### GIN

#### TANQUERAY TEN (47.3%)

The only Gin in the world to distill with whole handpicked fresh fruit botanicals. Bright citrus flavours of grapefruit, orange and lime with a delicate juniper and camomile influence. At it's best in our Perfect Ten martini with a pink grapefruit twist.

#### BEEFEATER (40%)

Created by James Burrough, a London pharmacist in 1863. Still produced to this day in Oval. Mellow Juniper with lemon, orange and a hint of violet. We'd suggest a traditional dry martini with orange bitters and zest .

#### HENDRICK'S (41.4%)

Not a London dry gin as juniper is not the predominant flavouring. Quirky and individual in nature, it is produced in Ayrshire in Scotland. Very individual in style, cucumber, rose petals and lychee. Turkish delight meets Borough Market. Delicious in a cucumber martini or with tonic and cucumber zest

### WHISKY

#### JOHNNIE WALKER GREEN LABEL (40%)

A smooth and elegant vatted malt with notes of vanilla, cooked fruit and nut. Finishes with that characteristic Johnnie Walker hint of smoke.

#### CAOL ILA 18yr (43%)

One of the many stars from the windswept island of Islay. A powerful malt with a big mouthfeel and a lovely long smokiness.

#### AUCHENTOSHAN 10yr (40%)

A classic example of a lowland malt. Clean, medium bodied with a soft and slightly sweet finish.

#### MACALLAN 18yr (43%)

Matured in Speyside in Spanish oak sherry casks, this malt is deliciously smooth with a slight sweetness and a touch of sherry and wood.

## SPARKLING WINES

You are in a supermarket looking at bottle of wine and trying to decide which one to buy. You have recently heard that there are vineyards in Britain and you think that today, rather than buying a bottle of French or Australian wine, as you usually do you will give your home country's produce a go.

There are nearly 400 commercial vineyards in England and Wales covering approximately 2000 acres of land in total. Nearly all are in the southern half of England and Wales. The most planted varieties of vine, mainly German in origin, have tended to produce wines which have both clear and distinctive characteristics but also a broad style.

The 2001 Blanc de Blancs made its mark in the 2008 International Wine Challenge gaining a Silver medal, as it also did in the Decanter World Wine Awards meriting another Silver medal. The winemaking team at Nyetimber believes this wine has not yet reached its full potential and has the hallmark qualities that will allow it to develop in time into a truly sensational wine.

## STILL WINES

### Chapel Down Bacchus Reserve 2007

31.00

A top class dry Bacchus. An intense nose, green herbs-rosemary, mint. The palate is concentrated and complex, crisp lime acidity, spicy apple, sherbet and rose petal which merge beautifully for a lingering, very long finish.

Made in a crisp, dry style that will appeal to those who like Sauvignon Blanc. Genuinely mouth-watering, this is highly refreshing and has finesse rarely found in English wines.

### Chapel Down Tullens Pinot Noir 2007

33.00

The first vintage with Pinot Noir from Chapel Down's new planting in Sussex. Dark plum red in colour with a complex bouquet of black cherry, blueberry and a mint lift. The wine is un oaked and has cherry and stone fruit on the palate. The finish is long and is aided by fresh acidity and rounded fruit tannins. Fine purple tints to the colour which naturally lead on to vivid aromas of violets and black fruits. Light on the palate with a mouth - watering coolness and underlying peppery character. Highly refreshing for a red, it would be lovely served with poultry which would bring out the full flavour.

## PIERRE GIMONNET CHAMPAGNE

We are delighted to introduce for the festive season, one of the exemplary Champagne growers in Champagne. A true growers Champagne, Didier Gimonnet continues the legacy of his grandfather Pierre, growing exclusively Chardonnay from his home in the village of Cuis on the Côte des Blancs. He tends his vines, grows his grapes and makes and bottles the Champagne himself.

The Gimonnet style is exhilarating – a pure, racy, elegant expression of Chardonnay, making it the aperitif Champagne par excellence.

### Cuis 1er cru NV 64.00

The essence of the Gimonnet style – 100% Chardonnay from the **Cuis 1er Cru** vineyard overlooked by Didier's home. Pristine minerality, racy freshness, a beautifully pure expression of Chardonnay. This is a blend of four vintages, using reserve wines from 2006, 2005, 2004 and a small portion of 2002.

### Extra Brut Oenophile 2000 1er Cru 68.00

Ultra focused, with zero dosage added (no sugar), creating a steely and super dry Champagne, absolutely beautiful with oysters and shellfish. A blend of **Cramant Grand Cru** (27%), **Chouilly Grand Cru** (49%) and **Cuis 1er Cru** (24%).

The purest expression of Chardonnay possible.

### Gastronome 1er Cru 2004 75.00

The freshness and minerality of **Cuis 1er Cru** (40%), with the richness of fruit from **Cramant Grand Cru** (11%) and **Chouilly Grand Cru** (49%). A vintage Champagne that Didier created for pairing with food in particular, hence the name "Gastronome".

### Millésime de Collection Vieilles Vignes 1999 – (MAGNUM) 120.00

If sparkling Puligny-Montrachet existed, it would surely taste like this. A stunning blend of **Cramant Grand Cru** (45%), **Chouilly Grand Cru** (30%), 25% **Cuis 1er Cru** (25%), with some of the vines over 40 years old. This has richness, depth, a creamy mouthfeel yet still with the vibrant freshness which is the Gimonnet signature – a special occasion wine, all the more grand for only being made in magnums - just 5000 bottles produced.

## ORGANIC AND BIODYNAMIC

### What is Biodynamic ?

*Key to biodynamics is considering the farm in its entirety as a living system. To this end, biodynamic farms are supposed to be closed, self-sustaining systems. Biodynamics also sees the farm in the context of the wider pattern of lunar and cosmic rhythms. In this holistic view, the soil is seen not simply as a substrate for plant growth, but as an organism in its own right. The idea of using synthetic fertilizers or pesticides is thus an anathema to biodynamic practitioners. Instead, they use a series of special preparations to enhance the life of the soil, which are applied at appropriate times in keeping with the rhythms of nature. And disease is seen not as a problem to be tackled head-on, but rather as a symptom of a deeper malaise within the farm 'organism': correct the problem in the system and the disease will right itself.*

*Biodynamics is in effect a supercharged system of organic farming. Where biodynamics differs significantly in practice from organics is in the use of special preparations and the timing of their application—in other ways the techniques employed are quite similar.*

*When talking to various biodynamic winegrowers from around the world, one thing has become clear. While they tend to agree on the big details, each has their developed biodynamics to suit their own particular situation. Winegrowers drawn to this philosophy tend to be inventive types, always experimenting and refining their practices to see what works best. As a result, there are many different flavours and variations around this common theme, and it's hard to define biodynamic agriculture in any sort of rigid way.*
